SCHOLARSHIPS

Did you know each year the North East Community Foundation offers more than \$73,000 in scholarships to high school seniors and adults furthering their education?



There are more than a dozen named scholarship funds coordinated through the North East Community Foundation. Some have been providing support to residents for decades, while others were established more recently. Each scholarship is distinct and recipients are selected based on criteria established by the donor.







FUNDS ESTABLISHED IN 2022 INCLUDE:

The Gunther Edelmann Scholarship Fund was established in honor of the former North East High School teacher and World War II veteran. Edelmann also coached NEHS wrestling and football and was inducted into the North East Athletic Hall of Fame. This scholarship is awarded to NEHS graduating seniors who plan to continue their education at an accredited post-secondary college or university, and who have demonstrated academic success, a strong work ethic, and a willingness to sacrifice for others and the greater good.

The Ethan K. Kalosky Scholarship was established in 2022 and is offered to current and former members of North East's Scout Troop 57 who have achieved the Eagle Scout designation. Candidates should be of good character and must demonstrate the same leadership, intellectual curiosity and love of community that Ethan Kalosky did.

GRANT HIGHLIGHTS

In 2022, with the help of our donors, NECF was able to grant nearly \$368,000 including:

MORE THAN \$182,000 TO EDUCATION

Supporting libraries and schools, providing college scholarships and funds for summer camp experiences in the arts and nature, we partnered with Boy Scout/Cub Scout Troops 57 & 86 to send kids to camps; The Door Student Services to send at-risk teens for a weeklong summer camp and helped install a basketball court at their facility; McCord Library for ongoing programming; and North East Arts Council to help fund Missoula Summer Theatre camp for kids, Picnic in the Park featuring free weekly entertainment and crafts for children, and an Art Immersion program for adults.

A \$52,500 multiyear grant from NECF helped bring The Stem & Vine program to the North East School District offering yearlong after school programming and summer enrichment in science, technology, engineering and math, with a special focus on local agriculture to grades kindergarten through 5.

In addition, more than \$73,000 in scholarships were awarded to assist local high school seniors and students of all ages who are pursuing higher education.



MORE THAN \$76,000 TO BASIC HEALTH AND **SAFETY NEEDS**

Grants and funds distributed helped bring food, health care, clothing and basics to our area's most at risk through partnerships with Community Nursing Services of North East for nursing and hospice care; Crescent and Fuller Hose Companies for ongoing service; and Project Love for holiday gifts.

A \$10,000 grant to 4 NINE Place helped bring the Group Cares program to North East over the summer, assisting senior citizens with needed home improvements.

Meanwhile two \$5,000 grants to the North East School District Foundation helped stock backpacks with weekly

food distributions to get students through the weekend without going hungry.

New boots and coats were distributed to those in need through 4 NINE Place and the Lions Club with a \$1,500 grant while the United Way provided free tax assistance with a nearly \$7,000 grant.

A collaborative grant of \$1,000 to the Northwest PA K-9 Search and Rescue team brought new equipment to help dogs and their handlers find lost loved ones faster.



MORE THAN \$69,000 TO ENRICH OUR COMMUNITY AND PRESERVE OUR UNIQUE HISTORY AND DOWNTOWN

Offering arts and culture and family fun through the Erie Philharmonic's free outdoor summer concert series, the July 4 fireworks and an expanded annual holiday light up celebration.

A \$10,000 grant to Downtown North East Inc. helped bring a new sound system to Gibson Park, while funds provided to North East in Bloom and the North East

Historical Society brought new planters and flowers to beautify downtown, along with historic postcard murals.
